SUBJECT : SUPPLEMENTAL GUIDELINES IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF 2011 PERFORMANCE CHALLENGE FUND (PCF) TO SUPPORT THE GAWAD PAMANA NG LAHI AWARD

In furtherance of the government's campaign on national government (NG) and local government unit (LGU) convergence in the advancement of economic prosperity, social well-being and environmental integrity, and in recognition of LGUs good performance and contribution to the attainment of the above development outcomes, the DILG is providing incentives to LGUs conferred with the Gawad Pamana ng Lahi: An Award for Exemplary Performance in Good Governance.

The Gawad is a total award concept and is conferred to a province, city or municipality for reason of exemplary performance in Administrative Governance, Social Governance, Economic Governance and Environmental Governance which graduated from Seal of Good Housekeeping to Seal of Good Governance.

In recognition of this, LGUs conferred with the Regional Gawad Award for 2011 are entitled to access the Performance Challenge Fund (PCF) subsidy to jumpstart local development initiatives aligned with the thrusts and priorities of the national government in order to achieve the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs), maintain core road network to boost tourism and local economic development, and comply with the Philippines Disaster Risk Reduction Act of 2010 and Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000.


The PCF subsidy shall be apportioned according to LGU level: Php 3 Million for a Province awardee; Php 2 Million for a City awardee; and Php 1 Million for a Municipality awardee.

In this regard and to fast track the release of the PCF subsidy, the DILG Field Offices are hereby directed to assist the Gawad Pamana ng Lahi awardees undertake the following:

1. PCF Availment
 - a. Submit Project Proposal to the DILG Regional Offices. The project has to be in the 2011 Annual Investment Plan; and

- b. Forge Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with DILG Regional Office to implement Local Development Project corresponding to the PCF incentive award.
2. Project Execution
 - a. Submit to DILG Regional Offices on a quarterly basis Physical and Financial Progress Report;
 3. Project Completion Reporting
 - a. Upon completion of the project, all LGU recipients shall submit to the DILG Regional Office the following documents:
 - i. Certificate and Report of Project Completion
 - ii. Certificate of Acceptance (if by Contract)
 - iii. Report of Disbursement verified by COA Field Office
 4. All LGU recipients shall post in conspicuous places within public buildings, DILG/LGU websites or print media the progress of project implementation, completed projects, including disbursed PCF subsidy.
