DILG-DBM Joint Memorandum Circular No. 01

**TO :** All Concerned Municipal Mayors, DILG and DBM Regional Directors, DILG Provincial Directors, DILG Municipal Local Government Operations Officers and All Others Concerned

**SUBJECT :** **POLICIES & GUIDELINES FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ASSISTANCE TO DISADVANTAGED MUNICIPALITIES PROGRAM**

**1.0 RATIONALE**

President Rodrigo Roa Duterte, in his Budget Message to Congress for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2017, outlined the role of LGUs as able partners in development. A portion of the budget philosophy states:

*“Our goal is to strengthen LGUs as able partners in national development. We fulfill this not by giving them additional funds out of political will or favor: we will condition such resources on their implementation of higher good governance standards, improvement of their capacity to generate resources, and strengthening of their ability to deliver basic services.”*

A total budget amounting to P19,430,560,495.00 has been included in the National Expenditure Program for FY 2017 for the implementation of the **Assistance to Disadvantaged Municipalities Program**.

**2.0 PURPOSE**

This Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) is being issued with the following objectives:

- 2.1** To prescribe the general policies and mechanics in the implementation of the Assistance to Disadvantaged Municipalities Program;
- 2.2** To ensure that all concerned are able to abide with the processes and responsibilities in the projects identification at the municipal level; coordination between LGUs and DILG and DBM regional offices; and budget integration at the national level; and

2.3 To provide oversight mechanism for the program implementation.

### 3.0 GENERAL GUIDELINES

- 3.1 This Program covers all municipalities except municipalities in the Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao.
- 3.2 Consistent with the general policy to provide a “catch-up mechanism” that will assist municipal governments in increasing citizens’ access to basic facilities in their respective areas of jurisdiction, an allocation that will allow the LGUs to identify projects that will be funded by the national government through this Program.
- 3.3 The budget cap of each covered LGU shall be determined by the following factors:
- 3.3.1 Equal share of each covered municipality from the total Program allocation;
  - 3.3.2 Per capita share of the municipality;
  - 3.3.3 Years-based share computed from previous national government allocations to the municipality; and
  - 3.3.4 Share for good performance.
- 3.4 The projects which shall be funded by the Program are those which are contributory to increasing access to basic services by the general citizenry.

### 4.0 PROJECT IDENTIFICATION

- 4.1 To ensure that there is an evidence-based decision process, the projects to be identified must be culled from any of the existing plans of the municipality (i.e. Local Development Investment Program; local disaster risk reduction action plan; or any sector-based or area-based plan of the municipality).
- 4.2 The projects to be identified must be in accordance with **Annex B** hereof. The specifications in the project menu shall be strictly followed. No deviation shall be allowed.
- 4.3 The municipal mayor shall submit a Projects List using the template in **Annex C** hereof. The projects shall be concurred by a duly-accredited CSO representative validated by the DILG thru the Municipal Local Government Operations Officer.

### 5.0 Budget Cap Per LGU





5.1 The amount of projects to be submitted by the Municipality must not exceed its 2017 budget cap as listed in **Annex A** of this Circular.

## 6.0 Project Types

The following project types may be requested for funding:

- 6.1 Water System Projects
- 6.2 Evacuation Facility
- 6.3 Local Access Roads
- 6.4 Small Water Impounding Project
- 6.5 Sanitation Facilities

**Annex B** hereof specifies the general description of each project type and its corresponding technical and financial standards.

## 8.0 Oversight Functions


The DBM and DILG shall subsequently issue separate issuances to provide guidelines in the release of funds, implementation process, and reporting requirements.
