MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

TO : ALL PROVINCIAL GOVERNORS, CITY AND MUNICIPAL MAYORS, ARMM REGIONAL GOVERNOR, PRESIDING OFFICERS OF THE SANGGUNIANs, DILG REGIONAL DIRECTORS AND OTHERS CONCERNED

SUBJECT : ENJOINING PARTICIPATION IN THE FNF-KAYA NATIN SCHOOL OF LEADERSHIP AND GOVERNANCE

The *School of Leadership and Governance* is a program of the **FNF-Kaya Natin Movement** that aims to train and develop young local government leaders to become effective, ethical and empowering public servants. **Forty (40)** incumbent local legislators aged 21-35 years old will be admitted to the program. It will run for Six Months with the participants attending a two-day seminar workshop every other month in Metro Manila.

In view of the above, and upon the request of Mr. Harvey Keh from the Kaya Natin Movement for Good Governance and Ethical Leadership, all Local Chief Executives are enjoined to allow the participation of their Vice-Governors, Vice-Mayors, Provincial Board Members, City/Municipal Councilors, who are aged 21-35 years old, to the said Program, on official business, upon submission of application forms and Updated Resumes or Curriculum Vitae, subject to the evaluation of the FNF Assessment Team.

Food and workshop materials are free of charge. However, payment of traveling expenses, and board and lodging will be shouldered by the participant, and may be authorized in accordance with, and subject to applicable limitations prescribed in *COA Circular No. 2012-003* dated October 29, 2012, chargeable against available local funds and to the usual accounting and auditing requirements, and to all pertinent laws, rules and regulations.

Chosen participants are also tasked to craft their respective Re-entry Action Plans (ReAP) upon the completion of the training program to be implemented once they return to their workstations.
