MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

TO : ALL CONCERNED PROVINCIAL GOVERNORS, CITY AND MUNICIPAL MAYORS, REGIONAL/PROVINCIAL CHAPTER OFFICERS OF ULAP MEMBER LEAGUES, AND DILG REGIONAL DIRECTORS OF REGIONS I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, NIR, VII, VIII, NCR AND CAR, AND ALL OTHERS CONCERNED

SUBJECT : ATTENDANCE TO THE STRENGTHENING DRRM FINANCING OF LOCAL GOVERNMENTS - ROADSHOWS ON THE NEW NDRRMF GUIDELINES

The Union of Local Authorities of the Philippines (ULAP), together with its member leagues and the Coalitions for Change (CfC) program, supported by the Australian Embassy and The Asia Foundation (TAF) partnership in the Philippines and the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) and the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) through the National Disaster Risk Reduction Management Council (NDRRMC), will conduct a series of fora/local roadshows, namely *“Strengthening DRRM Financing of Local Governments - Roadshows on the new NDRRMF Guidelines”*.

The series of fora aims to facilitate information dissemination and discussion on the revised guidelines among stakeholders, including local government units (LGUs) and to engage the Regional Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (RDRRMCs) and the OCD-Regional Offices into consultations/discourses on their involvement and the roles on the revised approval process. The fora shall serve as a venue for all the key leaders to enhance capacities and knowledge of local stakeholders on the revised guidelines on the administration of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (NDRRMF).

Moreover, the **objectives** of the regional fora are:

- To introduce and provide IEC materials/program on the revised NDRRMF Guidelines to local stakeholders;
- To conduct a series of local roadshows to facilitate information dissemination and discussion on the revised guidelines among local stakeholders, including LGUs and regional offices of NGAs as lead evaluating agencies; and,
- To engage the RDRRMCs and the OCD-Regional Offices into consultations/discourses on their involvement and roles on the revised approval process.

The two-day forum will be conducted in three (3) clusters on the following dates:
