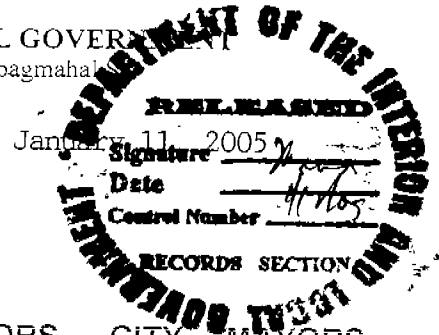

SUBJECT : 14<sup>th</sup> NMYL NATIONAL CONGRESS

The National Movement of Young Legislators (NMYL), will hold their 14<sup>th</sup> National Congress on March 3-5, 2005 at The Westin Philippine Plaza Hotel, Roxas Boulevard, Pasay City, with the theme: The Role of Young Legislators in Achieving Genuine Local Development: Revisiting the NMYL Agenda.

As represented, the said congress aims to convene young political leaders as part of the league's continuing advocacy for new politics and good governance. One of the highlights of the above-mentioned activity is the election of the league's National Executive Committee Officers.

In this connection, all concerned Provincial Governors, City Mayors and Municipal Mayors may allow the attendance of their Provincial Vice-Governors, City-Vice Mayors and Municipal Vice-Mayors, members of the *Sangguniang Panlalawigan, Sangguniang Panlungsod and Sangguniang Bayan*, who were 35 years old or below at the time of their election to office last May 10, 2004, in the said activity, on official business.

The payment of applicable travelling expenses and a registration fee of Six Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (Php 6,800.00), per participant, to defray the costs of hotel accommodation, meals and conference materials, exclusive of Annual and Membership Dues of Two Thousand Pesos (PhP 2,000.00), and One Thousand Pesos (PhP 1,000.00), respectively, may be authorized, chargeable against local funds, subject to the availability thereof, and to the usual accounting and auditing requirements. *It is understood that expenses shall not be charged against the 20% Development Fund, or against whatever fund source that prejudice on-going poverty alleviation efforts.
