ADDENDUM TO MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 2005-16

RE: BARANGAY ASSEMBLY DAY FOR THE FIRST HALF

OF CY 2005

Relative to the scheduled Barangay Assembly Day on March 19, 2005, all Punong Barangays are requested to advocate the establishment of a Barangay Registry of Inhabitants in their respective barangays as provided in Section 394 of the Local Government Code of 1991.

In view thereof, DILG MC 2005-16, dated February 23, 2005 is hereby amended to include as one of the agenda during the Barangay Assembly Day, the advocacy on the registration of barangay inhabitants in their barangays during the assembly day. Emphasis must be given on the functions of the Barangay Secretary as provided in Section 394 (d) of the Code, as follows:

"xxx (d) The Barangay Secretary shall:

- (1) Keep custody of all records of the sangguniang barangay and the barangay assembly meetings;
- (3) Prepare a list of members of the barangay assembly, and have the same posted in conspicuous places within the barangay;
- (5) Assist the municipal civil registrar in the registration of births, deaths, and marriages;
- (6) Keep an updated record of all inhabitants of the barangay containing the following items of information: name, address, place and date of birth, sex, civil status, citizenship, occupation, and such other items of information as may be prescribed by law or ordinances;
- (7) Submit a report on the actual number of barangay residents as often as may be required by the sangguniang barangay. xxx"
