SUBJECT : OBSERVANCE OF NATIONAL AWARENESS WEEK FOR THE PREVENTION OF CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE AND EXPLOITATION 2007

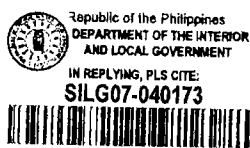
Proclamation No. 731, issued on February 1996, declared the 2nd week of February of every year as the "National Awareness Week for the Prevention of Child Sexual Abuse and Exploitation". This year's celebration will take place on February 4-10, 2007 with the theme "**IT TAKES A COMMUNITY TO PROTECT A CHILD FROM SEXUAL ABUSE**".

The annual observance of the said National Awareness Week seeks to help make our communities safe haven for children. All Local Chief Executives are hereby encouraged to spearhead and support the observance of this significant event in their respective jurisdiction by undertaking activities such as, but not limited to, the following:

1. Hanging of Streamer
2. Announcement of Awareness Week for the Prevention of Child Sexual Abuse and Exploitation during Flag Raising Ceremonies
3. Lecture series/orientation/skills training relative to the protection of children against sexual abuse and exploitation
4. Lay Forum
5. Art/painting contest/quiz bee contest depicting this year's theme
6. Media blitz
7. Other activities

DILG Regional Directors and Field Officers are hereby directed to cause the widest dissemination of this Circular to concerned LCEs and sanggunians at the provincial, city, municipal and barangay levels. Monitoring reports on activities conducted by LGUs shall be submitted to the Secretary, through the National Barangay Operations Office (NBOO), within thirty (30) days after the week-long celebration.
