SUBJECT : ATTENDANCE TO THE 3RD NATIONAL TRANSPORT
COOPS CONGRESS, APRIL 26-28, 2007 AT LA VISTA
PANSOL, CALAMBA CITY, LAGUNA

The **Katipunan ng mga Kooperatibang Pansasakyan ng Pilipinas (KKPPI)** will hold its **3rd National Transport Coops Congress** on April 26-28, 2007 at La Vista Pansol, Calamba City, Laguna. The theme of the Congress is "**Transport Coops Power for Cleaner Air and Efficient Public Transport Service**".

KKPPI is composed of more than 500 transport service cooperatives representing more than 100,000 small operators and drivers of various types of vehicles including bus, mini-bus, trucks, jeepney, school service, fix/shuttle and tricycle.

The Congress aims to: (a) consolidate and strengthen transportation cooperatives in the country; (b) build stronger partnership with national and local governments; (c) discuss issues and concerns confronting the transportation sector both at the national and local levels to improve public transportation services; and (d) introduce business opportunities to members of transport cooperatives with the affiliated primary cooperatives.

In view thereof, all Local Chief Executives are hereby encouraged to allow their cooperative development officers or in-charge of transport to attend the said Congress. Registration and other related expenses maybe charged against local funds, subject to the availability of funds and to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
