2007 NATIONAL FLAG DAY CELEBRATION

In line with the nationwide observance of the anniversary of the Proclamation of the Philippine Independence, the National Historical Institute has lined-up the following activities appropriate for the said significant historical event:

- May 21 to June 4, 2007 Watawat at Pambansang Awit, Launching of the Flag Advocacy Days
 - Putting up of streamers, flags or buntings in all government buildings, schools, universities, hospitals, public parks, restaurants/hotels, department stores or malls and banks, and
 - Monday Flag or National Anthem Ceremony Program in government NGAs, GOCCs, GFIs, LGUs, LG Leagues, private and civic organizations,
- ❖ June 4 to June 15, 2007 Kalayaan 2007 Independence Day Events or activities
- ❖ June 18 to June 29, 2007 Kabayanihan-Rizal Day and Fil-Spanish Friendship Day

One of the activities for this celebration, the "Paggalang sa Watawat" will highlight the observance of the National Flag Day or Flag Reverence on May 28 to June 30, 2007, which will also serve as the kick-off ceremony for the 2007 Independence Day Celebration.

To make this year's celebration more meaningful, all Local Chief Executives, in collaboration with NGOs and POs, are hereby enjoined to conduct simple and fitting programs, and are encouraged to display the Philippine Flag from May 28 to June 30, 2007 in every home, government building, public place and major thoroughfares or roads.

Likewise, all DILG Regional Directors are directed to cause the immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum Circular within their respective jurisdictions.
