MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

SUBJECT

AMENDMENTS TO MC NOS. 2001-86, 2003-116 AND 2007-43

(EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT PROGRAM - ESP)

Consistent with the human resource development thrust of the Department, the Educational Support Program (ESP) shall be amended as follows:

- M. Sanctions Grantees who fail to adhere to the Department's rules and regulations while on ESP shall be subjected to administrative sanction, to wit:
 - 5. Failure of grantees under the Masteral Studies Category to submit a certified true copy of grades at the end of every semester shall be a ground to hold his/her 13th month pay and other bonuses/benefits within the said semester/year. Moreover, he/she is barred from availing of any local/foreign scholarships/trainings/seminars/workshops, even after he/she had finished his/her service obligation.

N. Grantees under the Review Class Category must submit a proof of admission to the BAR examinations from the Supreme Court for BAR reviewees and a certificate from the Philippine Regulatory Commission (PRC), for CPA board examination reviewees.

SECTION IX - INCENTIVES AND AWARDS

A grantee who graduates with honors will be awarded by his/her respective office, the amount of five thousand pesos (P5,000.00), subject to the availability of funds, and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

All other provisions stipulated in MC Nos. 2001-86, 2003-116 and 2007-43 which are not inconsistent hereof shall still remain in force.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately.
