MUNICIPALITIES, AND DILG REGIONAL DIRECTORS

SUBJECT

REPEAL OF MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR 2005-143, DATED DECEMBER 15,

2005, AND TITLED, "FIRE AND LIFE SAFETY ASSESSMENT REPORT"

The Department of the Interior and Local Government is committed to aggressively scale up interventions to elevate the practice of governance that values transparency, accountability and performance into an institutionalized status.

Reports have reached this Department on the alleged involvement of some Bureau of Fire Protection officers in the preparation of the Fire and Life Safety Assessment Report and in the sale of fire extinguishers to applicants of Fire Safety Inspection Certificates.

In this connection, all City Mayors and Municipal Mayors are hereby:

- Informed that the Fire and Life Safety Assessment Report is no longer required as a supporting document in the issuance of a Fire Safety Inspection Certificate, and consequently Memorandum Circular 2005-143 dated December 15, 2005, titled, Fire and Life Safety Assessment Report is repealed effective immediately; and
- 2. Requested to cause the monitoring of compliance to this Department Directive, and to report to the Office of the Secretary any violation of, including the peddling of fire extinguishers by, Fire Marshalls.

All DILG Regional Directors and the Regional Governor of the ARMM are hereby enjoined to disseminate this Memorandum Circular to all local government units within their jurisdictions.
