FILIPINO HERITAGE FESTIVAL

The Filipino Heritage Festival, Inc. (FHFI), in partnership with the National Commission for Culture and the Arts and the Department of Tourism, will take the lead in the celebration of the Filipino Heritage Festival Month in May, 2011. The said event is in furtherance of Proclamation No. 439, series of 2003, entitled, Declaring the Month of May of every year as the National Heritage Month.

Part of the celebration is the launching of the Heritage Pilgrimage Campaign "Visiting the Philippines' National Cultural Treasures" on October 7, 2010 at the San-Agustin Church, Intramuros, Manila. Said campaign will involve traveling of pilgrims from various provincial and local communities, covering Regions I to X and NCR, where 34-Heritage Churches declared as the Philippines' National Cultural Treasures and UNESCO World Heritage Sites are located. This activity aims to promote awareness for their historical, artistic and architectural interests, recognizing and acknowledging that these 34-Heritage Churches have a strong tradition of religious meaning - for devotion, healing and spiritual significance for the majority of the Filipino people.
