TO: ALL PROVINCIAL GOVERNORS, CITY MAYORS, MUNICIPAL MAYORS, DILG REGIONAL DIRECTORS AND THE ARMM REGIONAL GOVERNOR

SUBJECT: OBSERVANCE OF ELDERLY FILIPINO WEEK ON OCTOBER 1-7, 2011

On September 26, 1994, President Fidel V. Ramos issued Proclamation No. 470, "Declaring the First Week of October Every Year as Linggo ng Katandaang Filipino (Elderly Filipino Week)".

This year, the celebration shall be observed on October 1-7, 2011 with the theme, "*Nakatatanda: Gabay, Tulay, Kaagapay at Bantay Tungo sa Kaunlaran*".

Relative to the above and pursuant to the request of the Department of Social Welfare and Development, all Provincial Governors, City Mayors and Municipal Mayors are hereby enjoined to celebrate Elderly Filipino Week by conducting activities such as, but not limited to the following:

- Walk-for-Life or walkathon to enhance health and well-being, preferably on October 1, 2011 as kick-off event;
- Forum on older persons' issues in the workplace; and
- Lecture on Health and Wellness.

All DILG Regional Directors and the ARMM Regional Governor are directed to cause the widest and immediate dissemination of this Memorandum Circular within their regional assignments and to provide assistance as may be necessary to ensure the success of the celebration.
