50th ANNIVERSARY TRIOLOGICAL CONGRESS

In the celebration of the 50th Founding Anniversary of the Department of Otorhinolaryngology, UP-PGH, Manila, a two-day congress will be held on November 10-11, 2011, at the Hyatt Hotel, Manila, with the theme "Honor, Service and Excellence".

The Triological Congress, organized by the Department of Otorhinolaryngology, College of Medicine—Philippine General Hospital, University of the Philipines, Manila, will provide local government doctors and nurses the opportunity to obtain updates on comprehensive care in the head and neck cancer, otology, audiology and neurotology, laryngology, rhinology and plastic reconstructive surgery.

In this connection, all local chief executives are hereby encouraged to allow the participation of LGU doctors and nurses to the said activity. The payment of applicable traveling expenses, and registration fee in the amounts indicated below, may be authorized chargeable against local funds, subject to the availability thereof, and to the usual accounting and auditing requirements and to all pertinent laws, rules and regulations. Provided, that the traveling expenses and registration fee shall not be charged against the 20% component of the Internal Revenue Allotment or from whatever source which may prejudice poverty alleviation efforts:
