SUBJECT : SCHOOL PERFORMANCE REPORT ON EDUCATION

The Universal Declaration of Human Rights in which the Philippines is one of the signatories provides that "everyone has the right to education. Education shall be free, at least in the elementary and fundamental stages. Elementary education shall be compulsory."

To further address the educational concerns, the Philippine National Plan of Action for the Education for All (EFA) was crafted which concretizes the state principles and policies on education that by 2015, *the Philippine is an educated nation where citizens are functionally literate and that it is to the best interest of the nation the need to provide social justice among those marginalized groups through the provision of the basic education for all.*

There are nine (9) Urgent and Critical Tasks of the Education for All (EFA) and one of which is "**make every school continuously improve its performance.**" In this particular task, all Local Government Units particularly Barangays are encouraged to have an annual reporting of school performance in their areas to gauge the educational situation in the community. To consider that the school is improving its performance, the following should be taken into account in the reporting (matrix attached), among others: 1) National Achievement Test (NAT); 2) Participation Rate or Net Integrate; 3) Completion Rate; and 4) Drop-out Rate.

The continuous improvement of school performance may be considered as a criterion for Special Education Fund (SEF) allocation and inclusion to DepED's School Implementation Plan (SIP). This will serve as an incentive to performing schools to sustain their educational programs/projects.

In this regard, all Barangays are directed to schedule the annual reporting activities preferably during their annual barangay assembly.

Likewise, all DILG Field Offices are hereby directed to assist the barangays to organize the annual reporting activities in coordination with the Department of Education (DepED).
