## MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

NO. 2011-160

TO

ALL PROVINCIAL GOVERNORS, CITY MAYORS, MUNICIPAL MAYORS,

REGIONAL GOVERNOR OF THE ARMM AND DILG REGIONAL DIRECTORS

**SUBJECT** 

**LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACTIONS RELATIVE TO UNDAS 2011** 

In view of the forthcoming Undas 2011 (All Saints' Day and All Souls' Day), every City Mayor and Municipal Mayor is hereby directed to:

- Convene the Local Peace and Order Council to formulate a contingency plan on peace and order and public safety;
- 2. Cause the mobilization and deployment of law enforcers, barangay tanods and medics in:
  - (a) Cemeteries' vicinity to ensure peace and order and public safety;
  - (b) Local and national roads to provide assistance to the traveling public; and
  - (c) Critical areas within the city or municipality in order to prevent the entry and exit of lawless elements;
- 3. Ensure garbage collection and clean-up of cemeteries and other public places before, during and after the Undas; and
- 4. Implement other necessary measures towards a peaceful and meaningful observance of Undas 2011.

The attention of every Provincial Governor is invited to the provision of Section 29 of the Local Government Code, which reads in part, quote:

SEC. 29. Provincial Relations with Component Cities and Municipalities. - The province, through the governor, shall ensure that every component city and municipality within its territorial jurisdiction acts within the scope of its prescribed powers and functions.

All DILG Regional Directors and the Regional Governor of the ARMM are directed to:

- 1. Cause the immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum Circular within their jurisdictions; and
- 2. Ensure that this Circular is effectively communicated to all concerned local authorities.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately.
