## SUBJECT : AMENDMENT TO DILG MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 2013-107, RE: 22-DAY MOTORCYCLE CARAVAN

DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2013-107 dated October 1, 2013 was issued to support the *22-day Motorcycle Caravan* of the Department of Transportation and Communications (DOTC), to kick-off on October 26, 2013 in Laoag City, and to end on November 17, 2013 in Zamboanga City.

However, the DOTC cancelled the entire Mindanao leg of the caravan retaining the original *Laoag City* kick off point on October 26, 2013, and to end in *Bacolod City* on the 17<sup>th</sup> November, 2013, passing through selected cities and municipalities in the Visayas.

In view of the above changes, local governments in Luzon and in the Visayas areas where the caravan will pass through are encouraged to undertake the following:

- Authorize to pass through their areas of responsibility;
- o Display streamers welcoming and supporting the caravan;
- Provide police visibility to maintain peace and order during the caravan;
- Schedule time for courtesy call by the caravan participants when requested;
- Identify possible venues for holding activities during stop-overs and rest days, when requested;
- o Enforce the Helmet Law; and
- Assign a Focal Person to whom the DOTC coordinator/s can discuss the details of the project.

Attached is the revised Motorcycle Caravan Schedule and Routes.
