



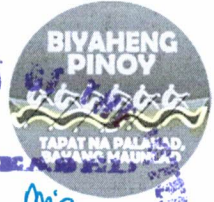

SUBJECT : FIRST INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON PRODUCTIVITY AND INNOVATION, TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 26-27, 2015 AT DAP CONFERENCE CENTER, TAGAYTAY CITY

The Development Academy of the Philippines, in cooperation with The Asian Productivity Organization, will spearhead the conduct of the *First International Conference on Productivity and Innovation*, to be held on November 26-27, 2015 at the Development Academy of the Philippines Conference Center (DAPCC), Barangay Sungay East, Tagaytay City, with the theme, "Achieving Excellence: Unlocking the Potential for Limitless Possibilities."

The conference aims to develop a culture of excellence amongst public and private sector organizations, with a focus on productivity and innovation. It is also an opportunity to recognize commendable practices of public sector organizations by way of the Philippines' Government Best Practice Competition (GBPC) 2015. Local winning entries may vie for the 4th International Best Practice Competition (IBPC). Some 300 local and international experts from public and private sector organizations from the Philippines and countries from Asia and the Pacific are expected to attend said conference, who will showcase best practices and current trends in promoting better governance.

In this connection, all Local Chief Executives are encouraged to attend the said conference. The payment of registration fee of PhP 10,000.00 per participant (inclusive of one [1] set of conference kit, conference meals, welcome dinner, closing dinner and one night accommodation), transportation and other incidental expenses may be charged against their respective local funds, subject to the availability of funds and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
