SUBJECT

2015 NATIONAL TEACHERS' MONTH CELEBRATION

Per Presidential Proclamation No. 242 issued on August 24, 2011, the period of September 5 to October 5 of every year was declared as the National Teacher's Month Celebration. This declaration calls for a nationwide celebration of teachers to be able to:

- Support the celebration of "World Teachers' Day";
- Revitalize the image of teachers in the Philippine Society and National Development;
- Celebrate the unique role and service that teachers play in guiding families, strengthening communities and building the nation; and
- Contribute to the growth and development of the teaching profession in the country.

Relative to this, the DILG as one of the member agencies of the National Teacher's Month Coordinating Council joins the Metrobank Foundation, Inc., and all the members of the National Teachers' Month Coordinating Council (NTMCC) in supporting the National Teachers' Month celebration which aims to engage the public in appreciating the contributions of Filipino Teachers and the nobility of the teaching profession.

Relative to the above, all Local Chief Executives are hereby to encouraged to conduct simple but meaningful activities such as, but not limited to, the following:

- 1. Display/Hanging of streamers, poster and other information materials in conspicuous places in the local government unit.
- 2. Promotion of a Teachers' Month Campaign that expresses appreciation to the teachers, both active and retired through LGUs local website (if available)
- 3. Organize special activities to honor teachers in your respective area;
- 4. Coordinate with the local media in featuring the roles and contributions of teachers in the development of youth in nation building; and
- 5. Disseminate National Prayer for Teachers (as attached) and pray as one community in offices or during flag-raising ceremonies every Monday from September 5 to October 5, 2015.
