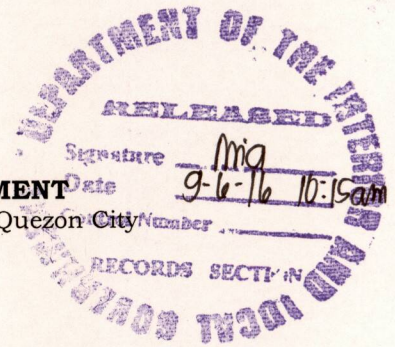

(CPAP) WEEK

Presidential Proclamation No. 588 issued on March 25, 2004 declared September 16-22 of every year as Cerebral Palsy Awareness and Protection Week.

Relative thereto, this year's celebration adopts the theme "Kung sa Cerebral Palsy ay may Kaalaman, Maganda ang Kinabukasan", which aims to promote a barrier free environment which will allow persons with cerebral palsy to enjoy productive lives.

In this regard, all Local Government Units are enjoined to support the observance by conducting fitting activities such as but not limited to the following:


- Hanging of advocacy streamers/tarpaulins in strategic places
