MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

SUBJECT : PARTICIPATION TO THE 8TH NICP ICT NATIONAL SUMMIT AND 5TH eGOV AWARDS FOR LGUs

The National ICT Confederation of the Philippines (NICP) will be conducting the 8th NICP National Summit and 5th Awards for Excellence in ICT for Good Governance of Local Government Units on November 10-11, 2016 in Tacloban City, Leyte.


The eGov Awards aim to recognize two (2) major categories namely, Best in eGov Customer Empowerment (G2C) Award and Best in eGov Business Empowerment (G2B) Award. The objective is to encourage the effective and efficient utilization of information and communications technology (ICT) in the delivery of services and performance of duties and responsibilities by local government units (LGUs). It also aims to commend and collate best practices of LGUs in integrating ICT in their processes to serve as example and benchmarks to other LGUs, to improve local business ecosystem and motivate the private/business sector to actively participate and/or invest in the growth of the LGUs, and to promote transparency in governance. In addition, there will also be Special Awards for Best in the Use of Cloud Computing.

Nominations for the eGOV Awards is open to all local government units such as a city, municipality or province. Only one (1) project per LGU can be nominated for each of the two categories. Hence, there can be two projects for an eGOV Year per LGU. Nominations forms can be downloaded from nicp.org.ph. Deadline of nomination is on August 31, 2016.

In this connection, all local government units are encouraged to participate on the above-mentioned activity on official business subject to availability thereof, and to the usual accounting and auditing requirements and to all pertinent laws, rules and regulations. Provided that, travelling expenses shall not be charged against the twenty (20%) percent component of the Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) or from whatever source that prejudice on-going poverty alleviation efforts.
