The Climate Change Commission (CCC) will hold the **First National Convention on Climate Change and Disaster Risk Reduction** on 06-08 December 2017 at the Sofitel Philippine Plaza Manila.

The National Convention aims to serve as a collaborative multi-stakeholder platform for knowledge exchange and cooperation on climate change action and disaster risk reduction interventions as well as a venue for peer-to-peer learning exchanges on best practices to pave the way for increased national and community resilience.

The thematic sessions of the Convention include: Disasters, Climate Change, and Sustainable Development Nexus; Linking Science, Policy and Practice; Mobilizing Resources for Low-Carbon, Climate-Resilient Development; and Preparing for the 'Big One'. Attached is the Provisional Programme.
