6th INTERNATIONAL YOUTH ASSEMBLY 2018

Republic Act No. 8044 otherwise known as the Youth in Nation-Building Act supports the principle of promoting and protecting the physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being of the youth to the end that the youth realize their potential for improving the quality of life.

The Youth and Students for Peace – Pilipinas (YSP) and World Collegiate Association for the Research of Principles (WCARP) will organize the 6th International Youth Assembly 2018 with the theme "Peace Loving Global Youth – Bridging Gaps toward Sustainable Peace" to be held at Iloilo City from September 20-23, 2018.

The said activity will highlight the keynote speeches of WCARP and YSP leaders and present the pressing issues of the youth today, it will also feature a presentation on universal peace principles which could help young people to understand society's core problems, guide them in finding their life purpose and inspire them to be catalysts to nation and peace building.

Another highlight of the activity is the Collegiate and Youth Ambassadors for Peace Awards which will recognize youth leaders who have made an impact in their communities through their exemplary character and peace initiatives.

In view of the above, all local chief executives are hereby encouraged to allow on official business the participation of their Sanggunian Kabataan Chairperson and Officers to the abovementioned activity.

The payment of registration fee in the amount of **Four Thousand Pesos (Php 4,000)** per participant to defray the costs of venue, meals and snacks and materials, and applicable travel expenses may be authorized chargeable against local funds, subject to the availability thereof, and to the usual accounting and auditing requirements and to all pertinent laws, rules and regulations.

The YSP and WCARP shall submit a post-activity report to the DILG Secretary, through the National Barangay Operations Office (NBOO), within a month after the conduct of the said activity, with the following prescribed format:

- I. Executive Brief;
- II. List of Participants;
- III. Outputs of Technical Sessions;
- IV. Issues and Agreements or Recommendations, if any;
- V. Total Fees collected and Disbursed; and
- VI. Appendices, if any.

Rationale

The International Youth Assembly (IYA) was conceptualized to rally the youth to commit to practicing universal life principles, encourage one another to build true and lasting relationships and enlighten them on their roles in nation and peace-building. MANAGEMENT

This assembly will be organized by the Youth and Students for Peace—Pilipinas and World Collegiate Association for the Research of Principles in partnership with the the Local Government of Iloilo City.

OUTPUTS

The participants are expected to present their ideas addressing the pressing issues concerning the youth. Participants shall also propose a resolution specifically on the role as nation builders advocating peace and progress in the country. It is also the aim of the assembly to allow young people to collaborate and create camaraderie, network among the other delegates, thus breaking the barriers between race, culture and religion.
