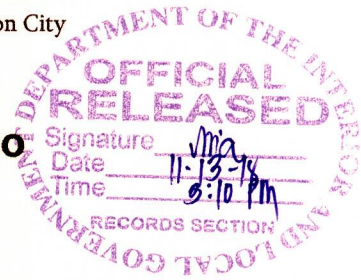

**100<sup>th</sup> DEATH ANNIVERSARY OF MARTIN DELGADO**

Memorandum Circular No. 2018-199  
November 13, 2018

**1.0 Background**

- 1.1. The National Historical Commission of the Philippines will conduct a commemorative program on November 12, 2018, for the 100<sup>th</sup> Death Anniversary of Martin Delgado, a revolutionary leader of the Visayas during the Philippine Revolution and Philippine-American War.

**2.0 Purpose**

This Circular enjoins all local government units and DILG officials and personnel to participate in the said activity or other events commemorating the 100<sup>th</sup> death anniversary of Martin Delgado.

**3.0 Scope/Coverage**

All Provincial Governors, City Mayors, Municipal Mayors, DILG Regional Directors, ARMM Regional Governor, and all others concerned


**4.0 Policy Content and Guidelines**

- 4.1. On November 12, 2018, a commemorative event for the 100<sup>th</sup> death anniversary of Martin T. Delgado, will be held in Sta. Barbara, Iloilo at 8:00 o'clock in the morning. All local government officials in the Province of Iloilo are enjoined to attend this activity.
- 4.2. All Local Chief Executives and all DILG Regional Officers, are likewise, enjoined to conduct simple but meaningful commemorative activities in their respective localities.
- 4.3. All DILG Regional Directors and the ARMM Regional Governor are, likewise, directed to cause the widest and immediate dissemination of this issuance to all local government units within their Regions.
