2018 NATIONAL MUSIC COMPETITIONS FOR YOUNG ARTISTS

(NAMCYA)

The National Music Competitions for Young Artists (NAMCYA) Foundation Inc., in cooperation with the Department of Education (DepEd), National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA), Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP), the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) and the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), announces the Launching of the 2018 National Music Competitions for Young Artists (NAMCYA) which culminates in the National Music Week with the title Anyaya sa Musika from November 20 to 25, 2018 at the CCP Complex, Roxas Boulevard, Pasay City. This is pursuant to Administrative Order No. 23, s. 2011 entitled Creating a Steering Committee on National Observances.

As per Presidential Proclamation No. 25, s. 1998, the last week of November of each year is designated as the National Music Week in which the NAMCYA Competitions are the main focus of the celebration.

Mechanics and Competitions Rules are as stated:

1. The solo instrument and group competitions for this year are as follows:

CATEGORIES	AGE ELIGIBILITY
A. YOUTH CHOIR CATEGORY (Equal and Mixed Voices)	At least 12 years old by August 3, 2018 but not more than 18 years old by November 23, 2018
B. CHILDREN'S RONDALLA ENSEMBLE CATEGORY	Not more than 12 years old by November 22, 2018
C. TRADITIONAL MUSIC	At least one lead performer should be not more than 18 years old on November 23, 2018
D. YOUTH SOLO RONDALLA INSTRUMENT CATEGORY	At least 13 years old by August 3, 2018 but not more than 18 years old on November 22, 2018

CATEGORIES	AGE ELIGIBILITY
E. JUNIOR STRINGS CATEGORY	Not more than 18 years old on November 21, 2018
F. JUNIOR PIANO CATEGORY	Not more than 19 years old on November 20, 2018
G. JUNIOR VOICE CATEGORY	Not more than 19 years old on November 21, 2018
H. GUITAR CATEGORY	Not more than 30 years old on November 20, 2018

2. The competitions will have four phases:

- a. First Phase: Online applications must be sent to the NAMCYA Secretariat office and must be received on or before 7:00 pm of July 27, 2018.
- b. **Second Phase:** Elimination Round All Categories will have the Elimination Round via video screening on August 2018.
- c. **Third Phase:** <u>Semifinal Round</u> For Group categories (Choir and Rondalla) and Solo Rondalla Instrument category, the Semifinals will be held on September 2018 at the selected venues in the following regional clusters in Luzon, Visayas, Mindanao, and Metro Manila:

The video screening for Traditional Music Ensemble will be held on August 2018. Six groups will be chosen to present at the National Finals Week at the Cultural Center of the Philippines on November.

Various Workshops and Clinics will also be offered for participants, trainers, teachers and other interested parties. Venues for the Semifinals and Workshops will be announced at a later date.

d. Fourth Phase: The National Final Competitions will be held at the CCP during the National Music Week from November 20 to 25, 2018, wherein the Regional Center Winners/Finalists will compete for the top prizes. Schedule of activities is listed below:

- 6. All rights to audio and video recordings of the competition belong to the NAMCYA.
- 7. The Secretariat assumes no liability to all forms of emergency during the course of the NAMCYA competitions and events.
- 8. By submitting the online application form, the participants confirm the acceptance of all conditions and guidelines of the competition.

I. SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

- A. Applications will be accepted only through the online application form. All forms and guidelines will be made available via the website www.namcya.com.
- B. All applications must be received by JULY 27, 2018. The Secretariat will not entertain incomplete and late applications.
- C. All attachments should be in a .zip file, or uploaded in a Google Drive or Dropbox link, sent via info@namcya.com

III. APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

ONLINE SUBMISSION

- 1. Filled up online application form (found at www.namcya.com).
- 2. Audition Video submitted via <u>Youtube unlisted link or Google Drive/Dropbox link</u> indicated in the application form.
 - a. Preferred video format is mp4, one camera set-up.
 - b. Video should be recorded after January 2018, and should include all members joining the competition.
 - c. Video should be without cut in between songs, no editing/zooming/panning, no audio enhancements.
- 3. High-resolution 4R size photo of the individual applicant or the participating group (including all members and the conductor joining the competition).
- 4. Scanned copy of birth certificate of each competitor. For groups, include birth certificate of conductor.
- 5. Scanned copy of the deposit slip for the registration fee.
- 6. Repertoire form for each Competition Level (as indicated in each Category).
- 7. All attachments should be in a .zip file or Google Drive/Dropbox link.

SUBMISSION OF MUSIC SHEETS (Hard copies submitted to the NAMCYA Secretariat)

Only Properly-acquired scores/music sheets must be submitted and used for the Competition.

- 1. Three (3) copies of Elimination Round Repertoire
- 2. Three (3) copies of Semifinal Round Repertoire
- 3. One (1) copy of Finals Round Repertoire

V. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

For use of non-public domain pieces, applicants shall be responsible for obtaining properly-purchased/licensed sheet music from composers, arrangers, and/or music publishers at all levels of the Competition, and written permissions or purchase receipts must be attached in the submitted sheet music. Please note that all NAMCYA-commissioned works and Contest Pieces are protected by copyright, and use should be limited to the competition and/or related events.

VI. PRIZES AND AWARDS

- A. First, Second, Third Prizes will be awarded in each category.
- B. A maximum of six (6) groups for the Traditional Music Category will be chosen to perform for the National Finals Week and will be given cash awards.
- C. Special Prizes may be given at the discretion of the jury.

VII. SUBSIDY

The NAMCYA shall provide partial subsidy for meals for all finalists from Metro Manila, while finalists from outside Metro Manila will receive partial subsidy for meals and accommodation, as well as inland transportation during the National Finals Week. Transportation going to Metro Manila and other food and accommodation expenses shall be borne by the contestants.

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
