ENGAGEMENT OF ALL CIVIL SOCIETY

ORGANIZATIONS (CSOs) AND INTERNATIONAL

AGENCIES (IAs) IN PREVENTING AND COUNTERING VIOLENT EXTREMISM AND INSURGENCY (P/CVEI) PROJECTS AND

ACTIVITIES IN THE PHILIPPINES

1. References:

- 1.1 The implementation of this Memorandum Circular (MC) is in support to Executive Order No. 70 series of 2018 entitled, "Institutionalizing the Whole-Of-Nation Approach (WNA) in Attaining Inclusive and Sustainable Peace, Creation of a National Task Force to End Local Communist Armed Conflict, and Directing the Adoption of a National Peace Framework." It aims to synchronize the effort of the government and the capabilities of private sector in ending the 50-year long deceit, lies and atrocities committed by the communist terrorists against the people and the government;
- 1.2 As stated on Chapter 18 of the Philippine Development Plan (PDP) 2017-2022 entitled, "Ensuring Security, Public Order and Safety", the participation of all government agencies, Local Government Units, international organizations, and local communities are important towards the attainment of addressing territorial integrity and sovereignty upheld and protected, reduction of all forms of criminality and illegal drugs, ensuring public safety, and ensuring the safety and security of overseas Filipinos.

1.3 The recently approved National Action Plan on Preventing and Countering Violent Extremism (NAP P/CVE) dated 27 May 2019 was crafted by the government in response to the growing radicalization in the country and as a contribution to the global effort to preventing and countering violent extremism. NAP P/CVE specifically aims to prevent radicalization leading to violent extremism through WNA or the convergence of the government, CSOs, religious sector and other stakeholders.

2. Coverage:

2.1 This Memorandum Circular (MC) shall cover all CSOs and IAs in all Regions and the BARMM which wants to engage in the implementation of programs and services related to preventing and countering violent extremism and insurgency;

3. Screening Process:

The Department of the Interior and Local Government supports the implementation of programs, projects and activities related to the prevention and countering of violent extremism and insurgency (P/CVEI). In response to the serious threats of terrorism, the Department identifies the importance of the CSOs and IAs in addressing the issues. However, DILG recognizes the need to synchronize NGA, CSO and IA projects and services in PCVEI for monitoring purposes, proper coordination and more proactive interventions against violent extremism. The multi-sectoral participation from the local communities and other stakeholders shall foster a strategic direction in the eradication of violent extremism and insurgency.

- 3.1 The CSOs and IAs intending to engage in P/CVEI program, projects and activities shall follow the specific procedures prior to its implementation and coordinate with the DILG field offices within their area of operation:
 - 3.1.1 Submit a formal letter addressed to the **SECRETARY** of the Interior and Local Government explaining the proposed projects/activities related to the implementation of EO no. 70 s. 2018, Cc: the DILG Regional Director and the Assistant Secretary for Peace and Security;
 - 3.1.2 Submit a **Concept Note** of the proposed programs, projects and activities with the attached format(*Please see attached Annex 1*); and

- 3.1.3 Accomplish the P/CVEI Programs/Activities Information Sheet **CSO Form 1** (*Please see attached Annex 2*).
- 3.2 CSOs and IAs with existing programs, projects and activities related to P/CVEI shall submit the following documents and coordinate with the DILG field offices within their area of operation:
 - 3.2.1 Submit a duly filled up P/CVEI Programs/Activities Information Sheet **CSO Form 2** (Please see attached Annex 3); and
 - 3.2.2 Submit a documentation of their implemented programs and activities that are related to P/CVEI.

4. Institutional Arrangements:

- 4.1 The DILG through the **Preventing and Countering Violent Extremism and Insurgency Project Management Office**(PCVEI-PMO) shall:
 - 4.1.1 Oversee the implementation of this policy:
 - 4.1.2 Coordinate with and provide technical assistance to the DILG Regional Offices and P/CVEI Focal Persons in the implementation of this MC;
 - 4.1.3 Monitor all the CSOs and IAs that implements P/CVEI programs, projects and activities;
 - 4.1.4 Take full responsibility for the vetting of the submitted proposed P/CVEI programs, projects and activities and recommend the list of CSOs and IAs to the SECRETARY for his approval; and
 - 4.1.5 Submit a quarterly report to the SECRETARY.

4.2 DILG Regional Offices shall:

- 4.2.1 Disseminate the policy to the DILG Provincial and Field Offices;
- 4.2.2 Coordinate with the DILG Provincial, City Directors and HUC/ICC P/CVEI Focal Persons in the implementation of this MC;
- 4.2.3 Oversee the implementation of this MC within their area of jurisdiction;
- 4.2.4 Submit the collated documents stated in **3.1** and **3.2** per province to the PCVEI PMO in hard copies and electronic copies; and
- 4.2.5 Submit a consolidated quarterly report on the implementation of this MC to the **PCVEI PMO** addressed to the Assistant Secretary for Peace and Security not later

than the 25th day of every quarter (March/June/September/December).

4.3 DILG Provincial Offices shall:

- 4.3.1 Coordinate with the City/Municipal Local Government Operations Officers in the implementation of this MC;
- 4.3.2 Oversee the implementation of this MC within the province;
- 4.3.3 Submit the documents stated in **3.1** and **3.2** per City and Municipality to the Regional Offices in hard copies and electronic copies;
- 4.3.4 Monitor the CSOs and IAs that implements programs and projects related to P/CVEI; and
- 4.3.5 Submit consolidated quarterly report on the implementation of this MC to the Regional Office not later 20th than the dav of every quarter (March/June/September/December).

4.4 DILG Field Offices shall:

- 4.4.1 Monitor the CSOs and IAs that implements programs and projects related to P/CVEI and require them to accomplish the documents as stated in **3.1**;
- 4.4.2 Coordinate with the CSOs and IAs that intends to implement P/CVEI programs, projects and activities and require them to accomplish the documents as stated in **3.2**;
- 4.4.3 Submit the documents as stated in **3.1** and **3.2** to the DILG Provincial Office; and
- 4.4.4 Submit a monthly report on the implementation of this MC to the Provincial Office every 25th day of the month.

5. Submission of Reports and PCVEI Proposals
