MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

No. 2019-140

TO : ALL PROVINCIAL GOVERNORS, CITY/MUNICIPAL MAYORS, PUNONG BARANGAYS, THE BARMM CHIEF MINISTER, THE BARMM MINISTER OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT, DILG REGIONAL DIRECTORS AND FIELD OFFICERS, AND OTHERS CONCERNED

SUBJECT : 2nd PHILIPPINE INTERCULTURAL YOUTH CONVENTION

Republic Act No. 8044 otherwise known as the Youth in Nation-Building Act supports the principle of promoting and protecting the physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being of the youth to the end that the youth realize their potential for improving the quality of life.

Sigaw ng Kabataan Coalition (SKC), the Rotary Satellite Club of Fort BGC Titans, together with its partners is hosting the 2nd Philippine Intercultural Youth Convention (PIYC) with the theme "New Beginnings for Peace, New Challenges for Development." It will be held on September 21-22, 2019 at the University Auditorium, Quezon City University. Around 500 young leaders are expected to gather and envision a bright future of the country, guided by our roots in heritage and history.

The overall objective of PIYC 2019 is to serve as a cultural platform for discussing the impacts and requirements of peace and development to and from the Filipino youth.

In view of the above, all local chief executives are hereby encouraged to allow on official business the participation of their Sanggunian Kabataan officers including Local Youth Development Council members, to the abovementioned activity.

The payment of registration fee in the amount of **Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 2,500.00)** per participant to defray the cost of convention kit, shirt, and meals for two (2) days, and applicable travel expenses may be authorized chargeable against local funds, subject to the availability thereof, and to the usual accounting and auditing requirements and to all pertinent laws, rules, and regulations.

The SKC shall submit a post-activity report to the DILG Secretary, through the National Barangay Operations Office (NBOO), within a month after the conduct of the said activity, with the following prescribed format:

- I. Executive Brief;
- II. List of Participants;

- III. Outputs of Technical Sessions;
- IV. Issues and Agreements or Recommendations, if any;
- V. Total Fees collected and Disbursed; and
- VI. Appendices, if any.

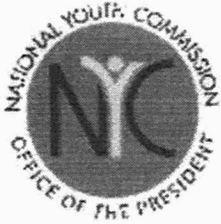


