SUBJECT : GUIDELINES FOR THE RELEASE OF THE 2019 PERFORMANCE CHALLENGE FUND (PCF)

The Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) began implementing the Performance Challenge Fund (PCF) for local government units in 2010. The PCF is a financial subsidy to qualified LGUs under the Local Governance Performance Management Program of the Department.

The PCF could be availed by LGUs that passed the Seal of Good Local Governance (SGLG): *Pagkilala sa Katapatan at Kahusayan ng Pamahalaang Lokal*. The SGLG is a performance audit to encourage and challenge all provinces, cities and municipalities to improve on their performance and service delivery.

The assessment conducted in CY 2019 Performance resulted to the recognition of Three Hundred Eighty (380) LGUs as 2019 Seal of Good Local Governance awardees. In view thereof, the CY 2019 SGLG awardees are hereby declared eligible to access the 2019 PCF incentives in the amount of P4.5 Million per Province, P3.5 Million per City, and P2.3 Million per Municipality.

The PCF incentive shall be given to LGU beneficiaries upon submission of the following documents at the onset:

- Checklist of Project indicating the proposed project duly approved by the LCE;
- Certified true copy of the Annual Investment Program (AIP) or Local Development Investment Program (LDIP) or Provincial Development Investment Program (PDIP) (page indicating the proposed project) by the Secretary to the Sanggunian; and,
- Government Bank Certification stating that the LGU has an Account Number of existing Trust Fund (for 1st Time recipient LGUs)

The PCF Operational Guidelines shall be made available the soonest for your immediate reference on the process and management of the proposed projects and its fund. Attached is the List of 2019 PCF Eligible Beneficiaries.
