Upon invitation of Dr. Raul Roland Sebastian, Director, Institute of Human and Social Development, Polytechnic University of the Philippines (PUP), all Local Chief Executives are encouraged to attend or send their representatives, to the National Conference on Local and Oral History, on April 14 to 16, 2019, at the Bulwagang Bonifacio of the Ninoy Aquino Library and Learning Resources Center, PUP Main Campus, Sta. Mesa, City of Manila

The said conference, with the theme, "The Colonial Government and Philippine Localities: Law, Public Order and Governance in the Spanish Period," is the response and contribution of PUP to the challenge of widening public knowledge about the evolution of political, social and economic life in the Philippines during the Spanish times. Further, the conference will provide a venue for fostering better understanding of local history during the Spanish period in relation to local development. The papers to be presented during the said conference will highlight the dynamic interaction between the colonized and the colonizers, including the impact of the latter in the localities during the colonial period.

Participants from the academe, government agencies, LGUs, and private sectors within and outside Metro Manila, are expected to attend the said conference. The conference is free of charge. The payment of travelling expenses may be authorized, chargeable against local funds, subject to the availability of funds, and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
