TO : ALL PROVINCIAL GOVERNORS, DILG REGIONAL DIRECTORS AND OTHERS CONCERNED

SUBJECT : 76TH NATIONAL ASSEMBLY AND ELECTION OF OFFICERS OF THE LEAGUE OF VICE GOVERNORS OF THE PHILIPPINES

Section 1, Article IX of the Constitution and By-Laws of the League of Vice Governors of the Philippines provides for the election of officers during the League's First Regular Meeting. For the term 2019-2020, the election of a new set of officers will be held during the League's 76th National Assembly scheduled on July 12-14, 2019 at the Sofitel Philippine Plaza, Manila.


In this connection, and upon the request of Vice Governor Antonio T. Albano, National President, LVGP, all Provincial Governors are encouraged to allow their Vice Governors to attend the said activity, on official business.

The payment of applicable traveling expenses and registration fee, if any, as well as Annual Dues as provided for under Section 2, Article IV of the League's CBL, may be authorized, chargeable against local funds, subject to the availability thereof, in accordance with, and subject to applicable limitations prescribed in COA Circular No. 2012-003 dated October 29, 2012, and to the usual accounting and auditing requirements, and to all pertinent laws, rules and regulations. Likewise, the participating local government officials are reminded of the provisions of DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2018-25 dated February 28, 2018, prohibiting local government officials and employees from entering, staying and/or playing at gambling casinos.

The LVGP National President shall submit a Post-Election Report to the Secretary of Interior and Local Government, through the Director of the Bureau of Local Government Supervision, within fifteen (15) days after the conduct of the said activity.
