WOMEN 2020 Entrepreneurship Summit Memorandum Circular No. 2020-010

1. Background

The Philippine Center for Entrepreneurship-Go Negosyo, in partnership with the Department of Trade and Industry and the Singapore Management University, will be holding the Women 2020 on March 3, 2020 at the World Trade Center, Pasay City.
