RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF KIDAPAWAN FOR THEIR BEST PRACTICES IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF COVID-19 VACCINATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, during the Joint RIATF-EID XII and RTF on COVID-19 Meeting held on December 9, 2021, DOH-CHD XII reported that as of December 9, 2021, Region XII's

vaccination coverage is 54% (partially vaccinated) 30.96% (fully vaccinated) and 14.75% were unvaccinated;

WHEREAS, to ramp up the vaccination rate in the region, local government units are encouraged to share their best practices in vaccination so that other LGUs can replicate the shared practices as a benchmark; hence, the City of Kidapawan in Cotabato Province, was requested by the Body to present their vaccination practices;

WHEREAS, the City of Kidapawan presented during the Joint Meeting its difficulties and challenges in reaching their vaccination target, however, they have evolving strategies with Local Vaccination Operations Center at the frontline. Aimed at systematic vaccination implementation, the following best practices were employed: Formulation of City Vaccination Plan, partnership with Notre Dame of Kidapawan College, hospitals, local schools, and colleges in the establishment of vaccination sites, resulting to 11 existing vaccination sites all over the City, pre-registration of eligible population through designing mobile application and provision of cellphones to BHWs who are assigned in the pre-registration, issuance of Executive Order creating a COVID-19 Nerve Center to handle all COVID-19 response actions including the vaccination implementation, “Libreng Sakay” and “Hatid Sundo” for vaccinees, Promotion of vaccination campaign through print, radio, and social media, “ResBUSkuna” – a mobile vaccination utilizing LGU-owned buses with free snacks and meals complement, provision of food packs (2 kilos of 7-tonner rice and 1 whole Magnolia chicken) to vaccinated individuals and health workers, provision of cash incentive to barangays who garnered the highest percentage of vaccination coverage amounting to P100,000.00 (1st Place), P75,000.00 (2nd Place), and P50,000.00 (3rd Place), respectively, and P20,000.00 cash incentive for each barangay that will reach herd immunity by the end of December 2021;

WHEREAS, as a result of all the initiatives done by the City of Kidapawan, they were able to partially vaccinate 97,000 individuals and fully vaccinate 83,970 out of their 110,166 targets. As of December 9, 2021, there are 32 out of 40 barangays that already reached beyond their 70% respective vaccination coverage;

WHEREAS, upon presenting the best practices in vaccination of the City of Kidapawan, the Body finds it commendable and worth replicating by other local government units of the Region;


NOW THEREFORE, on motion of RD Jeany T. Tedera of DOF-BLGF XII and seconded by RD Akmad J. Usman of DBM XII; **BE IT RESOLVED,** as it is hereby **RESOLVED,** to commend the City Government of Kidapawan for their Best Practices in the implementation of COVID-19 Vaccination Program;


RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to all members of the RIATF-EIDX II and RTF-COVID-19 XII and Hon. Joseph A. Evangelista, City Mayor of Kidapawan, for their information and to all local government units of Region XII for information and possible replication.


