In order to gain support to improved land administration and management for economic growth, the Strengthening Urban Resilience for Growth with Equity (SURGE), a project of the United States Agency for International Development (USAID), will organize a *Conference on Sustainable Land Management*, to be held on February 8 and 9, 2017 at the Diamond Hotel, Roxas Boulevard, Manila.

The said conference aimed to discuss and exchange best practice approaches in addressing constraints, including Gender and Social Inclusion (GESI) considerations, climate change and resiliency in land administration and management.
