

1. Any modifications in the item/s listed above during contract implementation must be approved by DILG-XII. The rate of each item/s shall not exceed the amount equal to the said item's published rate as of the date of return of this RFQ; **provided**, that the resulting total cost of item/s shall not exceed the total offered quotation for the same as contained in this RFQ.
2. Bidders shall provide correct and accurate information as required in this form.
3. Price quotation/s must be valid for a period of thirty (30) calendar days from the date of submission.
4. Price quotation/s, to be denominated in peso shall include all taxes, duties and/or levies payable.
5. Quotations exceeding the Approved Budget for the Contract shall be rejected.

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WHAT IS FEDERALISM

It is a principle where governments' powers and responsibilities are organized and shared between the federal (national) government and the state (regional).

BASIC PRINCIPLES OF FEDERALISM

Autonomy is allowing the regional and local governments to solve their own problems. It means that the regional (national) government to act. Regional governments are allowed to solve their own problems. They are closest to the problems at their own level, with no need for policy or budget approval from the national government.

Subsidiarity is decision-making at the level of the regional or local government. The essence of subsidiarity is that the federal government should only act when the regional government is unable to solve the problem. Regional governments are closest to the problems at their own level, with no need for policy or budget approval from the national government.

Sovereignty means that, while federalism will indeed involve the sharing of powers between the national and federated regions, including any that may be added heretofore, will remain part of a single country. One flag, one national sovereignty for all, federal (national) and federated regional governments alike.

TYPES OF FEDERALISM

COMING TOGETHER
The holding together model refers to historically independent states "coming together" to form a federation and therefore agreed to share their inherent sovereignty with the federal state. Some examples are the United States, Federal Republic of Germany, Britain and Spain.

BEING TOGETHER
The holding together type of federalism describes former unitary states opting to share their governmental powers to regions and local governments. Some examples are India, Spain, and Belgium.

FEDERAL SUPREME COURT
To settle actual controversies involving rights which are legally susceptible and enforceable.
FEDERAL CONSTITUTIONAL COURT
To decide conflicts between the branches and agencies of the Federal Government.
FEDERAL ADMINISTRATIVE COURT
To decide disputes involving constitutionality of laws and acts of the President and members of the Federated Regions.
FEDERAL ELECTORAL COURT
To decide electoral contests involving the President, Vice President, and members of Congress.

DISTRIBUTION OF GOVERNMENT POWERS

Section 1 | EXCLUSIVE POWERS OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT

- Defense, security of land, sea, and air territory • Foreign relations • International trade • Customs and tariffs • Citizenship, immigration and naturalization • National socio-economic planning • Monetary policy and federal fiscal policy, banking and currency • Competition and competition regulation bodies • Inter-regional infrastructure and public utilities including telecommunications and broadband networks • Postal service • Time regulation, standards of weights and measures • Promotion and protection of human rights • Basic education • Science and technology • Regulation and licensing of professions • Social security benefits • Federal crimes and justice system • Law and order • Civil, family, property, and commercial laws, which may be otherwise provided in the Constitution • Prosecution of graft and corruption cases • Intellectual property • Elections

Section 4, Article XII | SHARED POWERS

- Powers not exclusively given to either the Federal Government or the Federated Regions • They fall within the relative competencies of the Federal Government and the Federated Regions, which can be exercised jointly or separately in case of dispute or conflict in the exercise, Federal power shall prevail.

Section 2 | EXCLUSIVE POWERS OF THE FEDERATED REGIONS

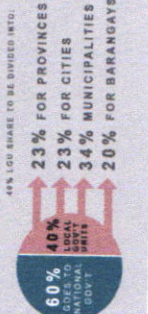

Section 5 | RESERVED POWERS

- Powers which are not exclusively given to the Federal Government or the Federated Regions nor shared by them and not prohibited by the Constitution • Reserved powers shall be vested in the Federal Government

39% OF THE NATIONAL GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED BASED ON THE LEGAL PRINCIPLES OF PROPORTIONALITY TO THOSE THAT REQUIRE SUPPORT TO ACHIEVE FINANCIAL VIABILITY AND ECONOMIC SUSTAINABILITY AS DETERMINED BY THE FEDERAL INTERGOVERNMENTAL COMMISSION. (Section 5, Article XII)

THE FEDERATED REGIONS SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO LEVY AND COLLECT THE FOLLOWING TAXES, LICENSES AND FEES: (A) REAL PROPERTY TAX, (B) SALT TAX, (C) DOCKAGE TAX, (D) PASSENGER TAX, (E) GATE AND AIRCRAFT TAX, (F) PERSONAL TAX, (G) VEHICLE REGISTRATION TAX, (H) TAX ON JET FUEL, (I) BOAT USER'S TAX, (J) VEHICLE REGISTRATION TAX, AND (K) TAX ON MOTOR VEHICLES AND (L) LOCAL TAXES AND OTHER TAXES WHICH MAY BE GRANTED BY FEDERAL LAW. (Section 2, Article XIII)

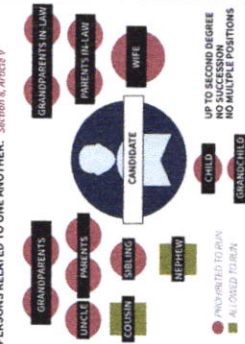
