

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WHAT IS FEDERALISM

It is a principle where governmental powers and responsibilities are shared between the national (federal) government and the state (regional) governments.

BASIC PRINCIPLES OF FEDERALISM

It is necessary to allow the regional and local governments to have the authority to make decisions on their own, without having to wait for any signal from the national government to act. Regional governments should be able to solve their own problems at their own level, with no need for policy or budget approval from the national government.

It is necessary to establish-making at the level of the regional government that by having the process of decision-making at the regional level, the needs of the constituents are better served. This is because the regional government is closer to the people and can respond more quickly to their needs.

It is necessary to ensure that, while each region is given more powers to the regional level, all the federative regions, including any that may be added in the future, will remain part of a single country. One important national responsibility for all federative (national) and federated regional governments alike.

TYPES OF FEDERALISM

COMING TOGETHER
Federalism under the coming together, made refers to historically independent states "coming together" to form a federation and therefore agree to share their powers. The United States, Federal Republic of Germany, and Switzerland.

HOLDING TOGETHER
The holding together type of federalism describes former unitary states coming to share their governmental powers with their regional governments. Some examples are India, Spain, and Belgium.

JUDICIARY

DISTRIBUTION OF GOVERNMENT POWERS

Section 1 Article XII EXCLUSIVE POWERS OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT

- Defense security of land, sea, and air territory; foreign relations and international trade; Customs and tariffs; Currency; Monetary and nationalization; National socio-economic planning; Monetary policy and foreign fiscal policy, banking and currency; Commercial and competitive regulation bodies; Inter regional infrastructure and public utilities including telecommunications and broadband networks; Postal service; Time regulation, standards of weights and measures; Promotion and protection of human rights; Basic education; Science and technology; Regulation and licensing of professions; Social security benefits; Federal crimes and justice system; and other Civil, family, property, and commercial law, except as may be otherwise provided in the Constitution.
- Prescription of debt and corruption cases; Intellectual property; Elections.

Section 4, Article XII | SHARED POWERS

- Powers not exclusively given to either the Federal Government or the Federated Regions. They fall within the relative competencies of the Federal Government and the Regional Government, which can be exercised jointly or separately in case of dispute or conflict in the exercise, Federal power shall prevail.

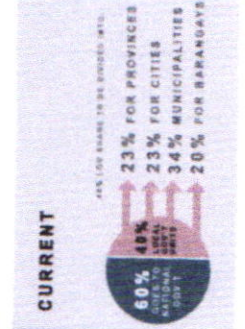
Section 3 Article XII EXCLUSIVE POWERS OF THE FEDERATED REGIONS

- Socio-economic development planning; Creation of sources of revenue; Financial administration and management; Tourism, investment, and trade development; Infrastructure, public utilities and public works; Economic zones; Land use and housing; Justice system; Local government units; Business permits and licenses; Municipal waters; Indigenous Peoples' rights and welfare; Culture and language development; Sports development; Parks and recreation.

Section 5 Article XII RESERVED POWERS

- Powers which are not exclusively given to the Federal Government or the Federated Regions nor shared by them and not prohibited by the Constitution. Reserved powers shall be vested in the Federal Government.

FISCAL POWERS and FINANCIAL ADMINISTRATION



39% of the total federal appropriations shall be distributed based on the shares of each regional, provincial and city/municipal government, as determined by the National Interregional Council. (Section 1, Article XII)

50% of the total federal appropriations shall be distributed based on the shares of each regional, provincial, city/municipal government, and barangay. (Section 4, Article XII)

50% THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO Levy AND COLLECT THE FOLLOWING TAXES, DUES AND FEES: (a) REAL PROPERTY TAX; (b) SALES TAX; (c) INHERITANCE TAX; (d) DONATION TAX; (e) GAMING TAX; (f) STOCK TAX; (g) VALUE-ADDED TAX; AND (h) OTHER TAXES, EXCEPT THOSE WHICH MAY BE GRANTED BY THE FEDERAL LAW. (Section 2, Article XII)

50% ENTITLEMENT FOR ALL THE FEDERATED REGIONS OF ALL NET REVENUES FROM THE CORPORATION, GOVERNMENT, AND UTILIZATION OF ALL THE NATURAL RESOURCES WITHIN THE TERRITORY. (Section 1, Article XII)

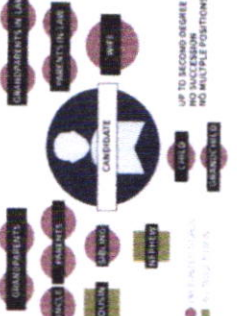

ECONOMIC: LEVELING THE BUSINESS LANDSCAPE



POLITICAL:

THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC SHALL GUARANTEE EQUAL ACCESS TO OPPORTUNITIES FOR PUBLIC SERVICE AND PROHIBIT POLITICAL DYNASTIES TO PREVENT THE CONCENTRATION, CONSOLIDATION OR PERPETUATION OF POLITICAL POWER IN PERSONS RELATED TO ONE ANOTHER. (Section 8, Article V)



CONSTITUTIONAL COMMISSIONS

FEDERAL CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

ADMINISTER THE CIVIL SERVICE WHICH ENCOMPASSES ALL BRANCHES SUBORDINATE INSTRUMENTALITIES AND AGENCIES OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, INCLUDING GOVERNMENT-OWNED OR CONTROLLED ENTERPRISES AND THEIR SUBSIDIARIES. (Section 1, Article X)

FEDERAL COMMISSION ON ELECTIONS

ENFORCE AND ADMINISTER ALL LAWS AND REGULATIONS RELATIVE TO ELECTIONS, INCLUDING RECALL, INITIATIVE, REFERENDUM, AND PETITION. (Section 2, Article X)

FEDERAL COMMISSION ON AUDIT

EXERCISE THE POWER, AUTHORITY, AND DUTY TO EXAMINE, AUDIT, AND REPORT ON THE RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES OF FUNDS AND PROCEEDS OWNED OR HELD IN TRUST BY AND CONDUCT PERFORMANCE AUDITS OF THE GOVERNMENT. (Section 2, Article X)

FEDERAL OMBUDSMAN COMMISSION

ACT AS AN OMBUDSMAN TO INVESTIGATE, IN ANY FORM OR MANNER, AGAINST PUBLIC OFFICIALS OR EMPLOYEES OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, AND TO CONDUCT IN APPROPRIATE CASES. (Section 1, Article X)

FEDERAL COMPETITION COMMISSION

CONDUCT "INQUIRY," INVESTIGATE, MARK, AND RESOLVE CASES INVOLVING ANY VIOLATION OF COMPETITION LAW. (Section 1, Article X)
